EOA seeks people interested in working in the Scenic Shops as Scenic Carpenters and/or as Scenic Artists.

- ⇒ These are seasonal opportunities with no guarantee of hours.
- ⇒ These opportunities are available on an as-needed basis for the Opera production season.

Employment:

- ⇒ Employees will be contracted by the Head of Scenic Carpentry or Head of Scenic Art for a set amount of time.
- ⇒ Any work exceeding 8 hours per day and 44 hours per week will be paid at the overtime rate.
- ⇒ This position has the flexibility to accommodate various employees and their prior commitments.
- ⇒ Wages as per the EO/IATSE Collective agreement.
- ⇒ Reports and are supervised by Head of Props/Paint and/or the Head of Scenic Carpentry and/or the departmental assistant heads.
- ⇒ This position is based out of EOA's Production Facility – these are not stage calls.

Qualifications:

- ⇒ Members in good standing with IATSE Local 210
- ⇒ Experience working in other scenic shops as applicable to your application.
- ⇒ Scenic Carpenter applicants with welding experience are likely to get more work this current season.
- ⇒ Scenic Artists may wish to include portfolio work as applicable.
- ⇒ Deadline-oriented with flexibility to adjust timelines as needed.
- ⇒ Knowledge and adherence of safe working practices.
- ⇒ Motivated to complete
- ⇒ Ability to remain positive, upbeat, professional with a calm demeanor.
- ⇒ A demonstrated willingness to promote a team atmosphere of respect and mutual co-operation with the other employees of EOA.
- ⇒ Physical ability: to climb, work on ladders / vertical lifts, lift up to 40 pounds and stand for long periods of time.
